



Cisco: Catalyst Center PowerPack Release Notes

Version 101

Overview

Version 101 of the "Cisco: Catalyst Center" PowerPack updates all Dynamic Applications to support pagination, and adds the new "Cisco Catalyst Center: Vlan Discovery" Dynamic Application.

- **Minimum Required Skylar One (SL1) Version:** 12.3.1

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Before You Install or Upgrade

Ensure that you are running version 12.3.1 or later of Skylar One before installing the "Cisco: Catalyst Center" PowerPack.

Installing or Upgrading the PowerPack

NOTE: If you are currently using the Dynamic Applications in this PowerPack to monitor devices, collection errors might occur for one or two polling cycles during the installation of a new version. To prevent collection errors during an upgrade, you can optionally disable collection for monitored devices before performing the following steps and re-enable collection after the upgrade.

To install this PowerPack:

1. Search for and download the PowerPack from the **PowerPacks** page at the [ScienceLogic Support Center](#) (Skylar One > PowerPacks).
2. In Skylar One (formerly SL1), go to the **PowerPacks** page (System > Manage > PowerPacks).
3. Click the **Actions** menu and choose *Import PowerPack*. The **Import PowerPack** modal appears.
4. Click **[Browse]** and navigate to the PowerPack file from step 1.
5. Select the PowerPack file and click **[Import]**. The **PowerPack Installer** modal displays a list of the PowerPack contents.
6. Click **[Install]**. The PowerPack is added to the **PowerPack Manager** page.

TIP: By default, installing a new version of a PowerPack will overwrite all content in that PowerPack that has already been installed on the target system. You can use the **Enable Selective PowerPack Field Protection** setting in the **Behavior Settings** page (System > Settings > Behavior) to prevent the new version of the PowerPack from overwriting local changes for some commonly customized fields.

- This PowerPack is compatible with Python 3.11.

Enhancements and Issues Addressed

The following enhancements and addressed issues are included in this release:

- Added the new "Cisco Catalyst Center: Vlan Discovery" Dynamic Application and aligned the existing "Cisco: Catalyst Center Vlan" Dynamic Application as a child Dynamic Application.
- Added the new "Catalyst Center Vlan" device class.
- Updated all Dynamic Applications to support pagination when fetching data using REST API.
