Overview

Version 102 of the Cisco: Cloud Center PowerPack adds the ability to monitor configuration data and performance metrics from Cisco CloudCenter devices, including CloudCenter Manager, CloudCenter Orchestrator, RabbitMQ, and component devices.

- **Minimum Required Platform Version:** 8.2.0
- **Support Status:** Beta

Installation Process

To install version 102 of the Cisco: Cloud Center PowerPack, perform the following steps:

1. If you have not done so already, upgrade your system to the 8.2.0 or later release.
2. Download version 102 of the Cisco: Cloud Center PowerPack from the Customer Portal to a local computer.
3. Go to the **PowerPack Manager** page (System > Manage > PowerPacks). Click the Actions menu and choose *Import PowerPack*. When prompted, import version 102 of the Cisco: Cloud Center PowerPack.
4. After importing the PowerPack, you will be prompted to install the PowerPack. Click the Install button to install the PowerPack.
5. See the manual *Monitoring Cisco CloudCenter* for instructions on using the new PowerPack.

Included Features

The following features are included in version 102 of the Cisco: Cloud Center PowerPack:

- The following Dynamic Applications are included in the PowerPack:
 - Cisco: Cloud Center CCM Component to Physical Merge
 - Cisco: Cloud Center CCM Discovery
 - Cisco: Cloud Center CCO Config
 - Cisco: Cloud Center CCO Discovery
 - Cisco: Cloud Center Cloud Configuration
 - Cisco: Cloud Center Cloud Discovery

- Cisco: Cloud Center Cluster Discovery
 - Cisco: Cloud Center Component Counts
 - Cisco: Cloud Center RabbitMQ Discovery
 - Cisco: Cloud Center Region Configuration
 - Cisco: Cloud Center Region Discovery
 - Cisco: Cloud Center Root Device Reclassification
 - Cisco: Cloud Center Tenant Configuration
- Device classes for all discovered devices are included in the PowerPack.
 - Six event policies are included in the PowerPack.
 - A Basic/Snippet credential template is included in the PowerPack.

Known Issues and Limitations

The following known issues and limitations apply to version 102 of the Cisco: Cloud Center PowerPack:

- All devices associated with a Cisco Cloud Center instance must be monitored by the same Data Collector.
- If you delete a Cisco Cloud Center device and subsequently want to re-discover the same Cisco Cloud Center device, you must execute the following database query on the Data Collector or All-In-One Appliance that monitored the Cisco Cloud Center device:

```
DELETE FROM cache.dynamic_app WHERE key LIKE %ccc%;
```
