Version 101

Overview

Version 101 of the *Cisco Collaboration Automation Policies* PowerPack updates the PowerPack name and updates the default Policy Type of the included automation policies.

Before You Install

Ensure that you are running version 10.1.0 or later of SL1 before installing *Cisco Collaboration Automation Policies* version 101.

NOTE: For details on upgrading SL1, see the appropriate [Release Notes](#).

Installation Process

To install this PowerPack:

1. Familiarize yourself with the *Known Issues* for this release.
2. See the *Before You Install or Upgrade* section. If you have not done so already, upgrade your system to the 10.1.0 or later release.
3. Download the *Cisco Collaboration Automation Policies* version 101 PowerPack from the Support Site to a local computer.
4. Go to the **PowerPack Manager** page (System > Manage > PowerPacks). Click the **[Actions]** menu and choose *Import PowerPack*. When prompted, import *Cisco Collaboration Automation Policies* version 101.
5. Click the **[Install]** button. For details on installing PowerPacks, see the chapter on *Installing a PowerPack* in the **PowerPacks** manual.

Version 101 of the *Cisco Collaboration Automation Policies* PowerPack includes the following features:
