Version 101

### Overview

Version 101 of the Cisco: TelePresence: Endpoint PowerPack addresses an issue concerning discovery, adds additional information to alerts in some Dynamic Applications, and updates the default thresholds for those Dynamic Applications.

• Minimum Required Platform Version: 8.14.0

• Support Status: GA

## Before You Install or Upgrade

Ensure that you are running version 8.14.0 or later of SL1 before installing the Cisco: TelePresence: Endpoint PowerPack version 101.

# Installing or Upgrading to Cisco: TelePresence: Endpoint PowerPack version 101

To install the Cisco: TelePresence: Endpoint PowerPack for the first time or to upgrade from a previous version, perform the following steps:

- 1. If you have not done so already, upgrade your system to the 8.14.0 or later release.
- 2. Download version 101 of the Cisco: *TelePresence: Endpoint* PowerPack from the Customer Portal to a local computer.
- 3. Go to the **PowerPack Manager** page (System > Manage > PowerPacks). Click the **[Actions]** menu and choose *Import PowerPack*. When prompted, import version 101 of the *Cisco: TelePresence: Endpoint* PowerPack.
- 4. After importing the PowerPack, you will be prompted to install the PowerPack. Click the **[Install]** button to install the PowerPack.

## Included Features

Cisco: TelePresence: Endpoint PowerPack version 101 includes the following features:

- Dynamic Applications that enable SL1 to discover, model, and monitor Cisco TelePresence endpoints
- Device Classes for each type of Cisco TelePresence endpoint monitored
- Event Policies and the corresponding alerts that are triggered when Cisco TelePresence endpoints meet certain status criteria.

## Enhancements and Issues Addressed

The following enhancements and addressed issues are included in version 101 of the Cisco: TelePresence: Endpoint PowerPack:

- The alert messages and default thresholds were updated in the following Dynamic Applications:
  - o Cisco: TP: Active Calls
  - o Cisco: TP: Active Calls (3-Screen)
- The following Dynamic Applications were updated to address an issue in which, if debug logging was enabled for discovery, security and privacy pass phrases that were encrypted when creating the credential were being logged. These Dynamic Applications now only log the credential ID:
  - o Cisco: TP: Peripheral Status (Main)
  - o Cisco: TP: Peripheral Status (Left)
  - o Cisco: TP: Peripheral Status (Right)
  - o Cisco: TP: Peripheral Status (Presentation)
