# Overview

Version 100 of the *RestorePoint Automation* PowerPack is the initial version of the PowerPack. This PowerPack introduces three Run Book Action policies, a Run Book Automation policy, and a custom Run Book Action that you can use with the *Datacenter Advanced Enrichment Actions* PowerPack.

- **Minimum Required Platform Version:** 8.14.0
- **Support Status:** GA

This PowerPack requires the following:

- A subscription to the SL1 Premium solution
- *Restorepoint* PowerPack version 101
- *Restorepoint Synchronization* PowerPack version 1.0.1
- *Datacenter Automation Utilities* PowerPack version 103

## Before You Install or Upgrade

Ensure that you are running version 8.14.0 or later of SL1 before installing the *RestorePoint Automation* PowerPack version 100.

**NOTE:** For details on upgrading SL1, see the appropriate SL1 [Release Notes](#).

**CAUTION:** You must install version 103 of the *Datacenter Automation Utilities* PowerPack before proceeding.

## Installation and Upgrade Process

To install the latest *RestorePoint Automation* PowerPack in SL1:

1. If you have not done so already, upgrade your system to the 8.14.0 or later release of SL1.
2. Search for and download the *RestorePoint Automation* PowerPack from the **PowerPacks** page on the [ScienceLogic Support Site](#).
3. In SL1, go to the **PowerPack Manager** page (System > Manage > PowerPacks).
4. Click the **Actions** menu and choose *Import PowerPack*. The **Import PowerPack** modal appears.
5. Click **[Browse]** and navigate to the *RestorePoint Automation* PowerPack file from step 1.
6. Select the PowerPack file and click **[Import]**. The **PowerPack Installer** modal page displays a list of the PowerPack contents.
7. Click **[Install]**. After the installation is complete, the *RestorePoint Automation* PowerPack appears on the **PowerPack Manager** page.

The following features were included in *RestorePoint Automation* version 100:

- Three Run Book Action policies:
  - Restorepoint: Difference between Last Two Backups
  - Restorepoint: Link to Last Configuration Backup
  - Restorepoint: Recent Logs
- The "Restorepoint Event Enrichment" Run Book Automation policy
- The "Restorepoint: Generic Action type" Run Book Action

- The "Restorepoint Connectivity" Dynamic Application, which validates the type of credentials used by Restorepoint
- The "Restorepoint Automation" Credential
